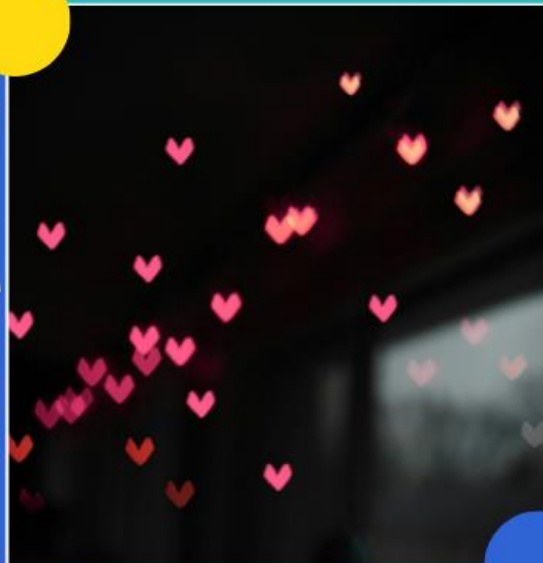
Our 2025 Oscar Prediction Contest is now open!
